REGISTRATION: Starting positions are determined by a random drawing of numbers prior to the event and will be announced at check in. The number is the boat's tournament identification number. SCORING: The Junior Trail tournaments are team events and the score will be based on a team's total weight in pounds. The tournament limit is 5 bass, 12 inches or longer. Participants cannot cull dead fish. A dead fish will not be weighed for lunker. In the event of a tie, points and prize money will be split. First place gets 100 points; second place gets 99 points, etc. In the event that a team member cannot fish an event, the other partner is permitted to fish alone for team points or fish one tournament with a substitute partner that is a member in good standing with the BNWV. The top fifteen teams in points will qualify directly to the State Championship. TOURNAMENT HOURS: Tournaments will run from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. In the event of weather delay, the Youth Director will decide on an extension of the tournament. Youth Director has the right to change start time due to low visibility. PENALTIES: All participants must check in with tournament officials at the official check-in site. Participants arriving late for weigh-in will be penalized 1 pound per minute. Any participants arriving 10 minutes late will lose the entire weight of their fish for that day. If a dead fish is weighed, 4 ounces will be deducted per dead fish and a short fish is a 1 pound penalty. Dead fish will not be weighted for lunker. SAFETY PFD's: Safety is #1. All competitors must wear and have secured to their person a U.S. Coast Guard-approved chest-type PFD at ALL TIMES during the operation of the gas motor. Competitors for yrs. and older and weighing more than 80 lbs. shall be permitted to wear an inflatable PFD. Each Boat Coach must wear a PFD and have a kill switch lanyard securely attached to their person anytime the outboard motor is running. *RPM Limit: Boat Coaches may only operate their boat at a maximum of 4500 rpm's, except in cas
